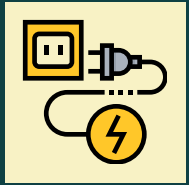

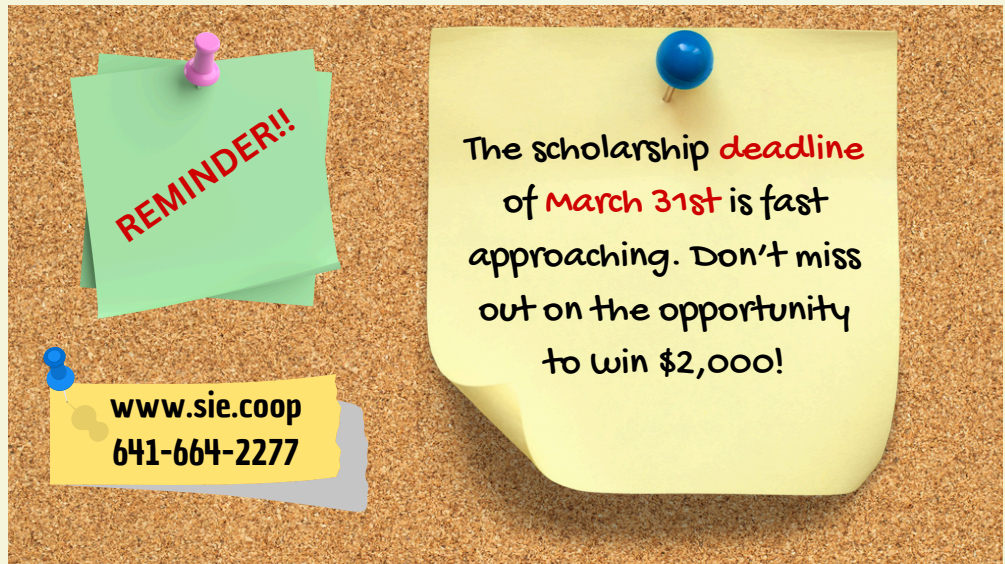

Community Fund Committee

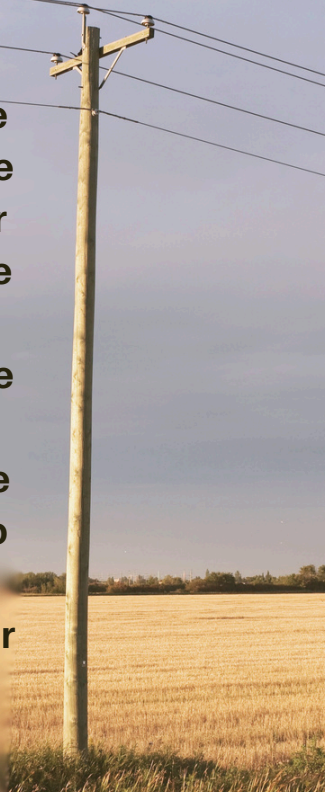
